A bright day and a memorable event summed up the occasion as members of the Lapeigu church of the Truth Repairers and Restorers Ministries (PNG), few miles out of Goroka town witnessed the dedication of their new church building. The Lapeigu church has a total congregation of around 80 members including children. Leading up to the dedication, the church hosted the Eastern highlands Provincial Meeting from 5th—11th of the 7th Month of the Gregorian Calendar,

2015. The highlight of the meeting was the opening and dedication of the local church building. Considering the surrounding communities, the church building is big and can accommodate up to 150 people at one time. The evangelization work of the Lapeigu church resulted in the birth of Hegu, Mando, and Rambao local churches.

Lapeigu church has two dedicated Elders namely; Elder Sam and Elder Kam-bi. Through the grace of God, Elder Sam left behind his Lutheran roots to restore the Sabbath, while Elder Kam-bi, shifted from the SDA faith.

The church have five missionaries with three currently serving in mission fields. Evangelist Osher is posted as the evangelist assigned for the Highlands Region. Missionary Elijah is currently serving in the mission field in Western Highlands Province, and Missionary Nathan is serving on his mission field at the Mando church in Eastern Highlands Province.

Missionary Enoch and Danny are serving their mission field back at their local church at Lapeigu and assisting their two Elders.

National Church Council in Place

History has been made yet again for this young but progressive movement. The Truth Repairers and Restorers Ministry has within a space of seven months into its establishment, already set in place its national council that will oversee the operation and growth of this young but vibrant movement.

Following the experiences of the past decade of moving the restoration message across the nation of PNG, poor administration and poor leadership had been the self inflicted wound to the movement and an antidote to a otherwise rising restoration movement. Unfortunate turn of events in the recent past added salt into the wound and set back the growth of the restoration movement. The fire has not totally gone

off though, and the turn of recent events has been a blessing in disguise as one may see it. Truth seekers emerged out of that rumble and are now providing the much needed guidance through the wisdom of God to set the course for the work entrusted to the remnant and keepers of the oracles of the message of restoration.

It was a day of relief when on the 26th day of the 7th month of the Gregorian calendar, the leaders of the Truth Repairers and Restorers Ministry formally elect to office the 13 representatives that will oversee the Ministry’s administration and growth. Gospel workers came from far and wide even as far as Kabwum in the remotest part of Morobe province to be

part of the exciting establishment.

Napamogana church in Bena, E.H.P was the scene of Elders and Gospel workers camping and engaging in spiritual discussions on the eve of the meeting and true to its intention, the meeting was presided gracefully and the outcome is an answer to many prayers.

“This is the first step,” said one Gospel worker. “With the grace of our God, we will climb all the way up to fulfill the calling God has placed upon each one of us,” he continued.

Work is now underway to register the movement with IPA to be a legal Christian Ministry.

Excitement brewing for POM 2nd Church

There is an excitement in the camp that has not been experience before. Port Moresby fellowship is now confirm to set up a second shelter for worship to continue the extension of the message of restoration in the nation’s capital and the Central province.

Work is already underway to clear and prepare the site for the shelter’s materials to be brought in.

“Folks at 9 mile and elsewhere who faithfully follow up on street preaching and other evangelization methods cannot hear the message that was

preached at Sabama church on the Sabbath day, due to various reasons, bus fares and long distances are but a few to mention”, said Benzamin Zairo. “They have the conviction but how could they come to know the importance of Sabbath, the ways to keep it Holy and be at the place to eat the meat of due season”? He went on. “We have an obligation to bring it to them as part of our mission to preach the gospel to the ends of the nation and the world as a witness then shall the end come”.

Accordingly, the same applies to Talai at Badili, in the Moresby South and that is where the second worship shelter for the Port Moresby ministry work will be established.

It is anticipated to be ready by the time, the Talai evangelical meeting is held in the early part of the 12th month of the Gregorian calendar in 2015.

Evangelization in Badiagwa Secondary School

It was in the sixth month of the Gregorian Calendar in 2010 that Kiunga had their first Sabbath gathering. A handful of followers following the street preaching by Evangelist Gideon Kassa on the week leading up had came together. The Lord had a touch on a family who took in the young street preacher and from there, the Katafa family has been the backbone of the church in Kiunga.

Since then, there had been two missionaries sent to Kiunga church namely Missionary Rocksy and Missionary Japheth. The latter is the current missionary of the church in Kiunga.

Being far from access to the restoration movement work in Papua New Guinea, they only heard after many months that a separation happened out from PTM.

While still contemplating the reasons of the separation, they faced yet again another notice of a separation.

They have since been a church without a name as they put it in summary since 2014. Eventually, on the 26th day of the 9th month of the Gregorian calendar 2015, Evangelist Gideon visited the church and the message of Isaiah 58:12

was shared to the church. By the time the Sabbath ended on that faithful Sabbath day, the church was declared the repariers and restorers of the breach.

“ You would wonder out there why we receive the name and recognition under the new ministry that late,” Mr. Katafa said. “You know we could not use this name after hearing it over the phone. Our missionary cannot announce it in church as it was treated as unreliable information with no confirmation,” he went on. “ There was no copy of written meeting minutes, and hearsay is unrealistic and uninformative for us to make a decision”.

Today we declare ourselves the Truth Repairers and Restorers.

who have been following the young missionary into street preaching and into the mountains with him to pray.

A number of weeklong meetings have been held in and around Daru town and on one occasion, the young missionary with the boys from the church were invited to the mainland for night meetings.

With the support and counsel from the three senior members of the church in Daru, the Lord has done many wonderful things on the island.

With the excitement growing, a request is made to the church in Papua New Guinea to continue to pray that whom the Lord has called into the gospel field, shall steadfastly with confidence and assurance of the coming reward be faithful unto the end.

Daru Church Moving Ahead with Steam

Daru church has been consistently growing as each day passes with workers took to the street declaring the message of restoration.

The church has since left the rental classroom and have moved into the messing hall of the school for their Sabbath fellowship.

Missionary Baiyo’s posting to the church in Daru has seen the increase in interests from young man and boys in the Western Province who wanted to be part of the extension of the message of Restoration and declaring the True God.

As we go into print of this story, there are about twenty young men and boys

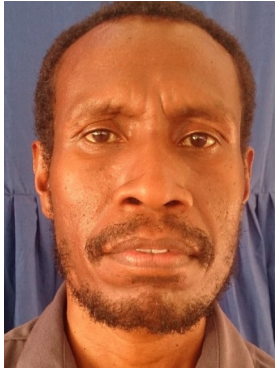

Tabari Place in 4 Mile, Port Moresby was a crowded atmosphere for a whole week from the 1st –5th of the ninth month of the Gregorian calendar 2015. People from all walks of life with various social status brave the heat of the Port Moresby sun to grab the most their ear can take.

It was a scene of enthusiasm as folks gathered as early as they can to await the arrival of the gospel workers. “Brother, we came as early as five in the morning and we have not had any breakfast yet”, said one committed follower to one of our young gospel workers. “We rushed with the office workers on the PMV bus just to come early and get the appropriate location so when the sun comes up, we would be comfortable at our location to get everything the

preacher boy said”, he continued.

Because of the large number of crowd following up, all young gospel workers from Port Moresby were mobilized on standby after every days’ preaching to answer to queries and expound more to interested listeners.

Missionary George indicated that, in whatever we do, let this be known to us that God is with us. “It is a sign that God is still interested in gathering people to hear the message of restoration,” Missionary George said afterward. True to the calling of presenting the message as pure as it is and without compromise, few gospel workers of first day churches approached the boys after preaching and compliment and urge them to continue on the preaching of the message without fear and favor.

A layman from the United Church had this to say; “I have not gone to church for many Sundays now, because they have agreed in our council meeting to allow Women Pastors to preach at the pulpit. Now I see why I had this conviction. It was a conviction God gave me”.

Request were even submitted from the crowds to bring the message to their local villages.

The introduction of the week long street evangelization was done by gospel worker Saike. Gospel worker Saike was a few days ago been to the surgery to remove a metal rod that was placed into his right arm that was there for 6 months after his arm was slashed. What a way to thank the Lord for his providence after a successful surgery.

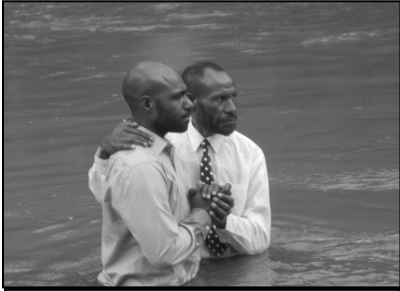

There is sickness everywhere, and most of it might be prevented by attention to the Law of Health. We (people) need to see the bearing of health principles upon our well-being, both of this life and for the life to come. We need to be awakened to our responsibility for the human habitation fitted up by our Crea-

tor as His dwelling place, and over which He desires us to be faithful stewards and helpers in this field. People need to be impressed with the truth conveyed in the Holy Writ:
